SITUATION

1. Level training for each cadet mandates that specific instruction will be given on marksmanship, survival, field craft, radio and radio procedure, navigation, range and leadership. In addition, optional training directives exist for adventure training.

MISSION

2. 296 City of Cambridge RCACS cadets and staff will participate in a field training exercise on 11 and 12 Jun 2022
3. Cadets will participate in training on a variety of mandatory and optional subjects including:

EXECUTION

4. Shades Mill Conservation Area is located inside Cambridge, with the entrance off of Avenue Road. Entrance fee will be managed by Sqn.
5. Messing (Sat Lunch, Dinner, Sun Lunch) will be MRE's.
6. No movements shall take place unless otherwise ordered.
 - a. Cdts will arrive each morning at Shades Mill for training by 0800h. Cadets will be directed at front gate where to proceed. Entrance fee will be paid by Sqn.
 - b. Cadets will be dismissed each day to be picked up by their parents.
 - a. 1730h Saturday dismissal time.

Location: Shades Mill.

Transportation: Via Parent Drop off / Pick up near gate. Cadets entrance fee will be paid by Sqn staff.

Accoms: Washrooms on site.

Dress: FTU uniform for weekend. Air Cdt dress regs apply.
Cadets whom arrive improperly prepared will not be attending.

Special Instructions: Any prescription medication will be reported to the unit Medical Officer upon arrival.
